### **Report of February 28, 2009 Discussions with Rell Administration**

The State Employees Bargaining Agent Coalition (SEBAC) again met with representatives of the Rell Administration on February 28, 2009.

Although the governor's representatives did not put forward a formal proposal until February 24, SEBAC leadership has responded with thoughtful, detailed, and sensible solutions at both our February 26 and February 28 meetings. Our sole aim is to reach a mutual agreement with the State as quickly as possible, and bring such an agreement back to our membership for ratification.

SEBAC leadership has continued to honor the Administration's request that we not publicly discuss the specifics of our meetings. While we continue to believe that a fair agreement is in the interests of both parties, and the public, no further meeting dates are currently scheduled.

We have made it clear, through words and actions, that we are ready to reach agreement to ensure that the public continues to receive the quality public services it needs in this time of crisis. We urged the Administration to rededicate its efforts not for its own interests, or for ours, but in the interests of the public we all serve.
