

ATTENTION MEDICARE ELIGIBLE RETIREES & SPOUSES of the
Connecticut Employees Union Independent

Effective January 1, 2012, SilverScript will administer prescription drug coverage for State of Connecticut retirees and dependents eligible for Medicare.

If you are **eligible for Medicare** you will receive a new SilverScript ID card for prescription coverage.

- **No action is required on your part.** You will be automatically enrolled in the group Medicare Part D prescription drug plan that works in conjunction with the State's "wrap" plan.
- **You must not opt-out of this plan.** If you do, you will lose both medical and pharmacy coverage.
- **Your benefits will not change.**
- **There will be no change in co-pays or covered drugs.**
- **You can continue to use the pharmacy you currently use to pick up your prescriptions.**

You do **NOT** need to get new prescriptions from your doctor. You will receive a new ID card in December for coverage effective January 1, 2012. Please show this new ID card at your pharmacy the next time you pick up a prescription. You will pay the same co-pays that you pay today.
